### FEEL THE RHYTHM

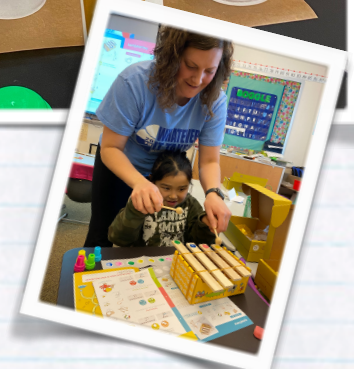
Participants teamed up to explore the world of rhythm and sound. Using the instructions and a team approach, xylophones were

constructed and music filled the air. Everyone enjoyed playing Puff the Magic Dragon after reading the book. Some students were even able to use their own creativity to create their own symphony.

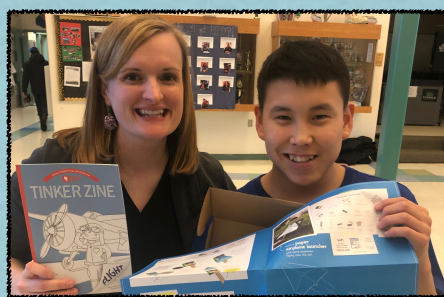


## STEM-ulating FUN!
