

The SWRS COVID-19 Programs Overview Summary of Changes
August 23, 2022

1. Transportation Section
 - a. CDC order under Section 361 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C 264) and 42 Code of Federal Regulations 70.2, 71.31(b) – “A Requirement For Persons to Wear Masks While on Conveyances And At Transportation Hubs” has expired.
 - b. As a result, masks are optional on vehicles involved in school transportation.
 - c. Social distancing on buses is encouraged but not required. Family members are encouraged to sit together when possible but not required.
 - d. Schools may assist with the sanitizing of vehicles for school transportation but not required.

2. Food Service Section
 - a. Hand washing is encouraged, not required.
 - b. Lunch will be served in common areas, not in classrooms.
 - c. Social distancing during lunch is encouraged but not required

3. Screen Protocol Section
 - a. This section has been removed. Screening protocols for all staff, students, and visitors when entering the school is no longer required.

4. Symptomatic Response Protocol for Visitors
 - a. Visitors displaying symptoms are encouraged to get a COVID Test before coming to the building.
 - b. The narrative about visitors not being allowed to return to the school for 10 days unless they receive a negative test result has been removed.

5. Positive Case Response Matrix
 - a. Contracting tracing protocols have been removed.
