Resolution 25-01

- WHEREAS, the Alaska Reads Act was passed by the state legislature and signed by the Governor, as an unfunded mandate, and
- WHEREAS, the Alaska Reads Act requires Southwest Region School District and all the schools within the district to implement the various components of the Alaska Reads Act, and
- WHEREAS, in recognizing that the Alaska Department of Education & Early
  Development is providing non-monetary support to school districts and
  schools to implement the Alaska Reads, and
- WHEREAS, the Southwest Region School District has provided the financial support through various funding sources including general fund, Title IA, the Migrant Education program, and the School Improvement program when possible for the implementation of the Alaska Reads Act,
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Southwest Region School District Parent Advisory Committee recommends that the School Board support the implementation of the various components of the Alaska Reads Act through a review of the current budget to determine if funding can be dedicated to provide professional development and structural supports to all relevant instructional staff on the programs and processes necessary to implement the Alaska Reads Act.
