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## TRAVEL & HOUSING PROVIDED

Academic Interventionists are flown from their home airport to Anchorage, Alaska for orientation and shopping before continuing on their way to their assigned school. Fully furnished housing is provided, at no cost, within walking distance to the schools. Housing includes all kitchenware, bedding, cooking and cleaning supplies. Travel home will be provided at the completion of the program.

Academic Interventionists are paid \$21/hour and work 37.5 hours per week for the 12 week program.

## SUPPORT NETWORK

After orientation, Interventionists stay in contact through weekly professional development meetings and group exchanges. Interventionists are provided RTI/MTSS tool kits onsite. Classroom teachers provide support and guidance for shared students and strategies. Site Principals develop schedules and include Interventionists in professional development opportunities.

## SMALL GROUP INSTRUCTION

Academic Interventionists work with small groups of students for 20-30 minutes using student data to provide effective intervention lessons in math and language arts. Focus grades K-5.
