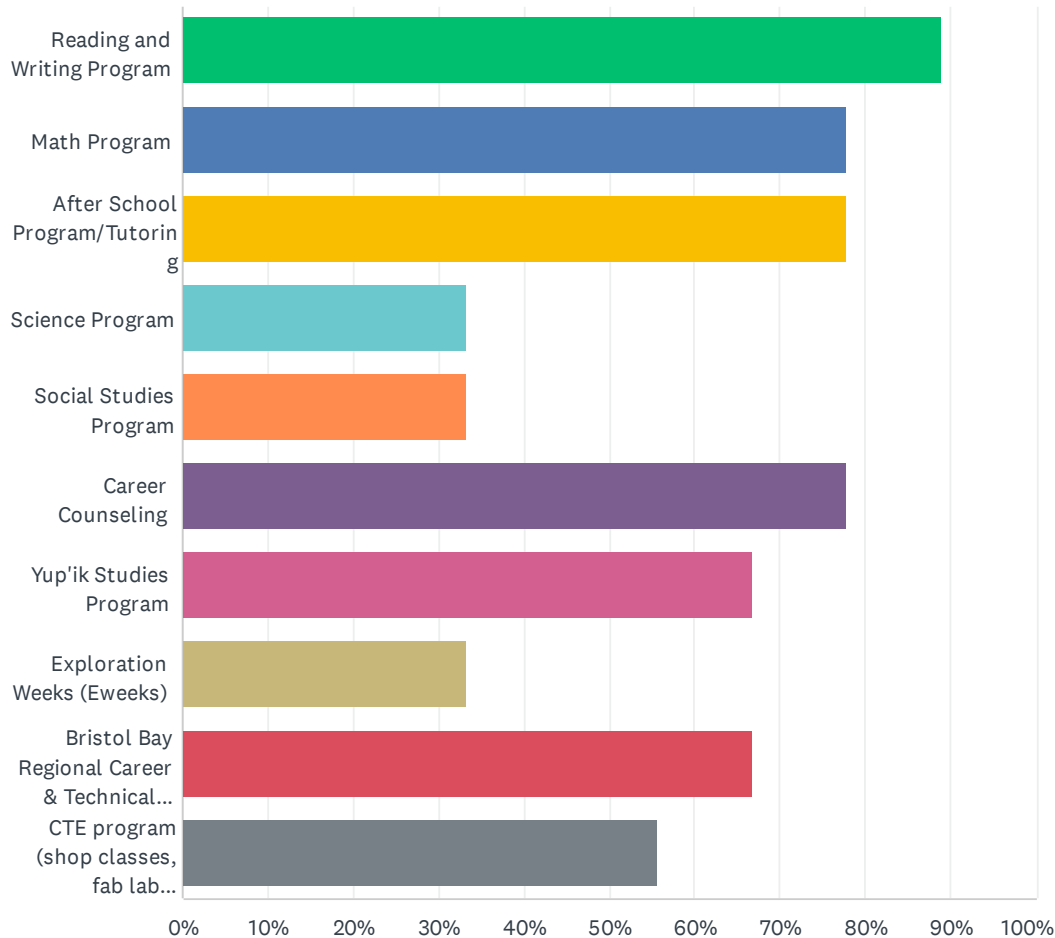

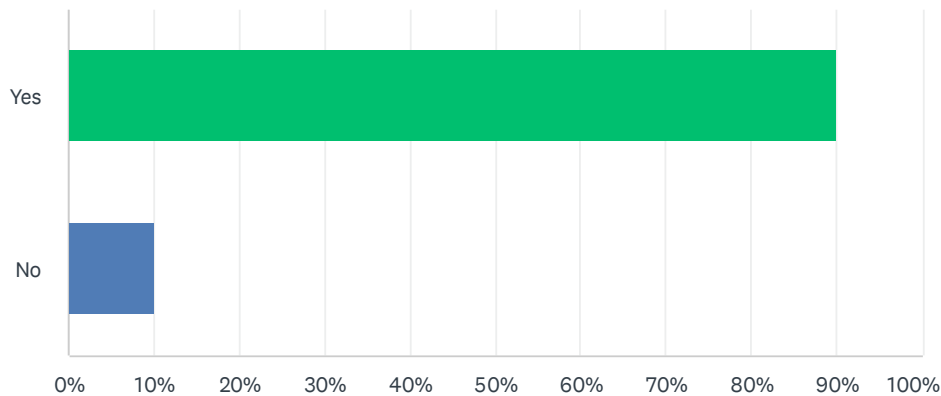

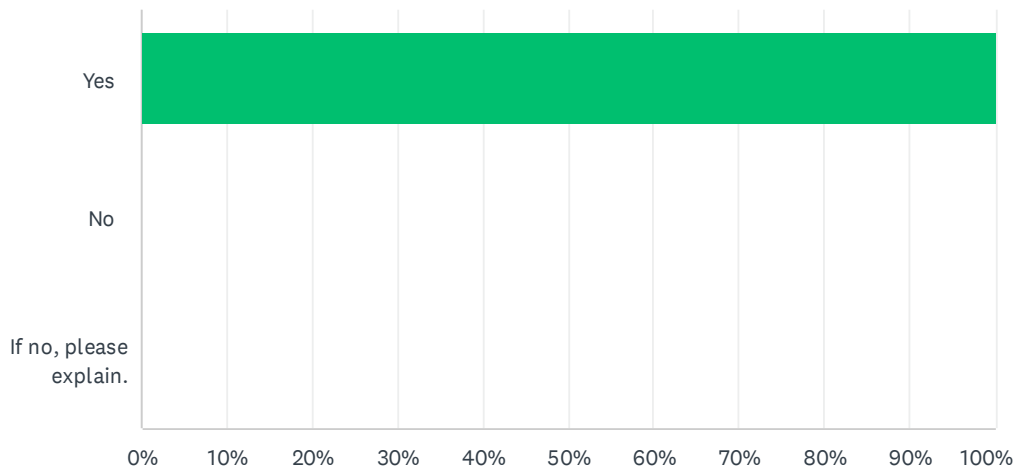

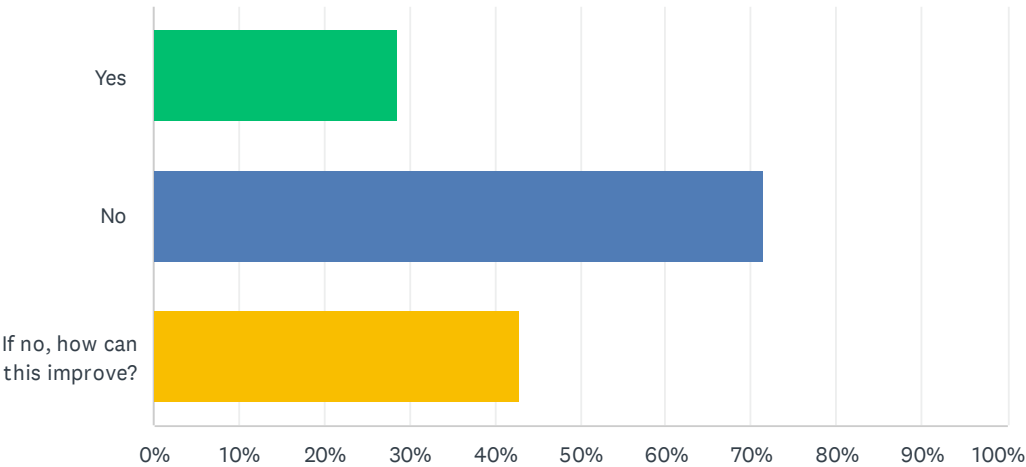

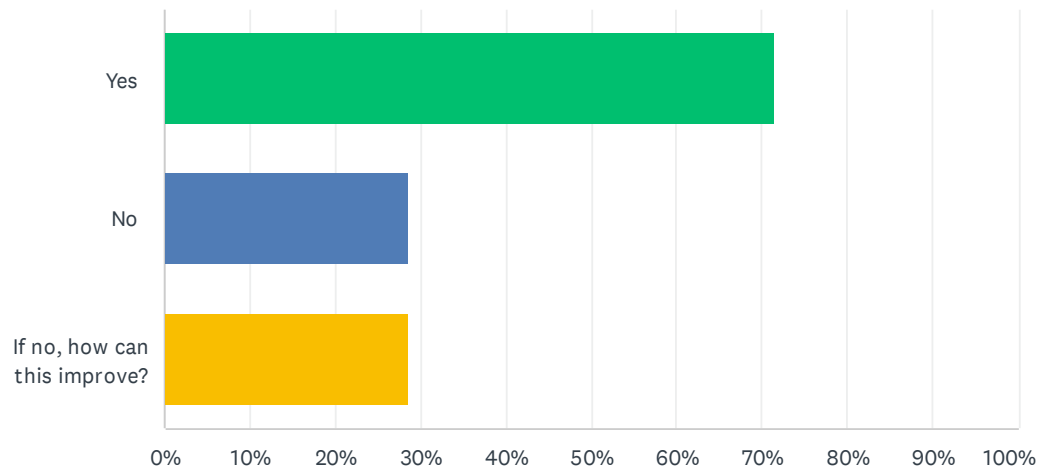
**Suggestions for improvement included:**

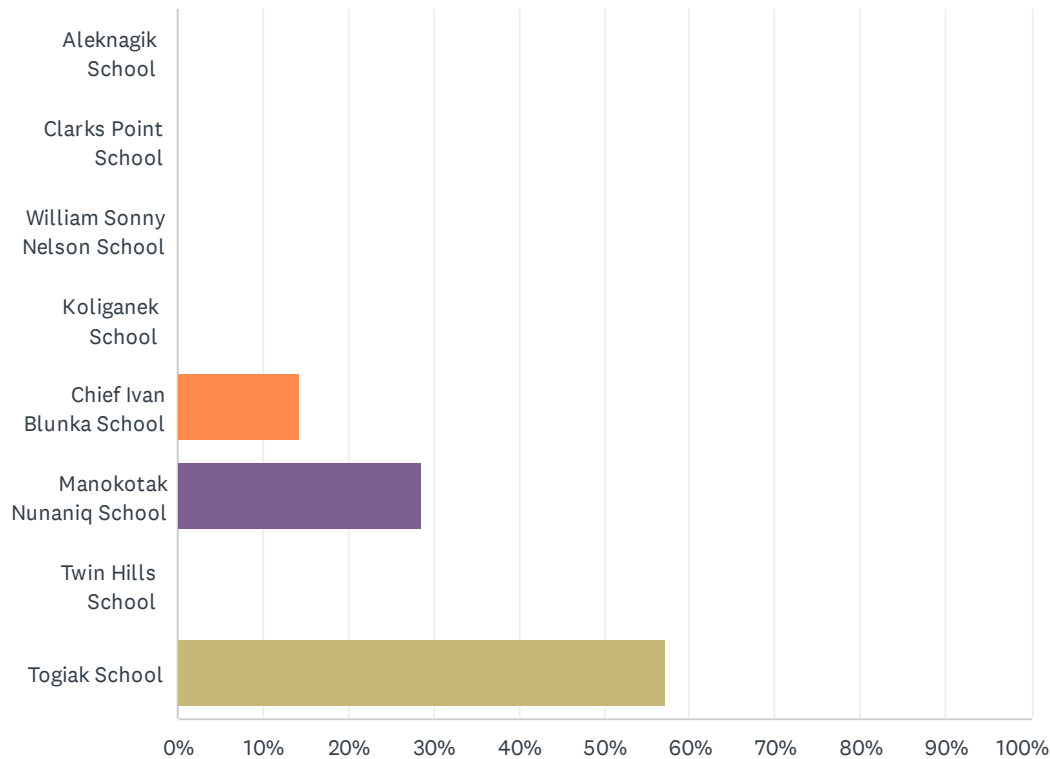

Q10 Which school does your child(ren) attend?

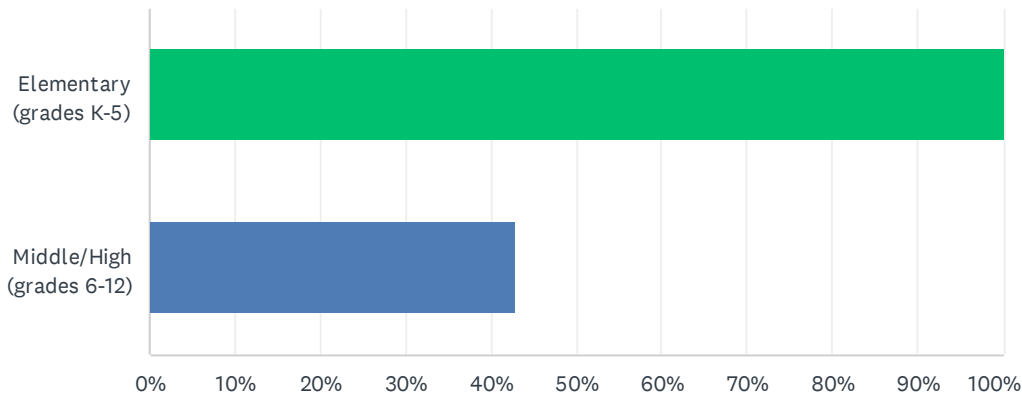
