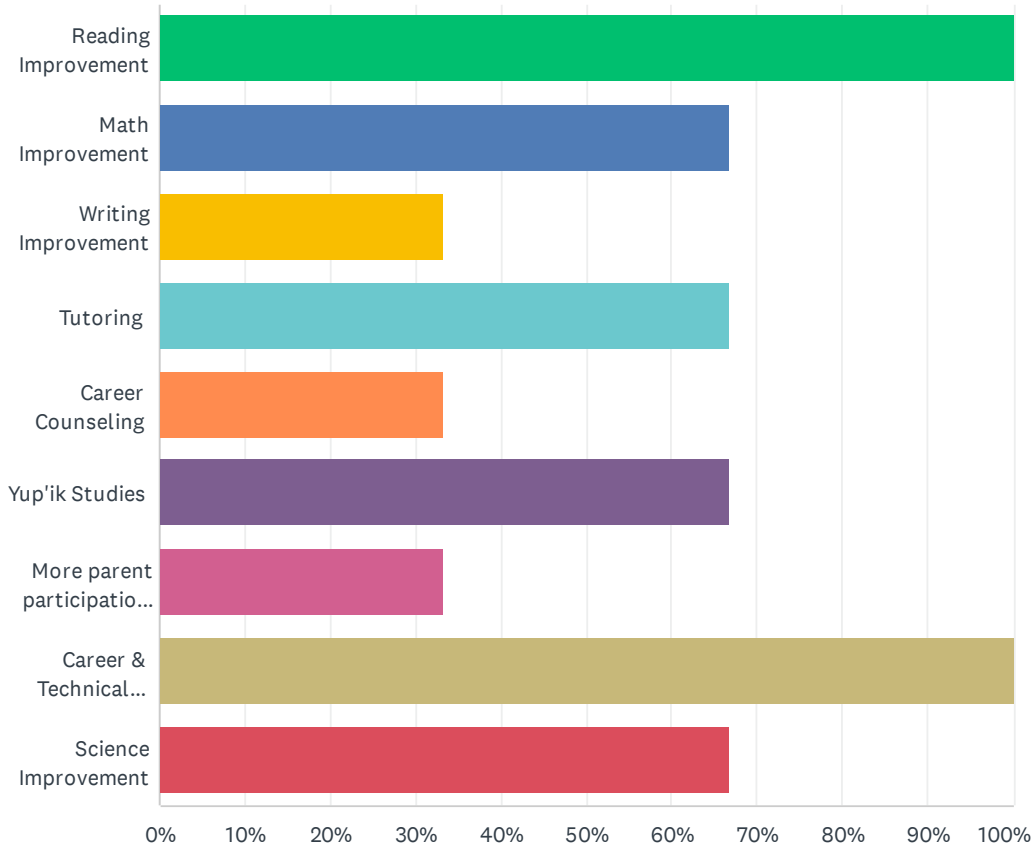


Q1 What do you feel are the main educational needs of children in your community?

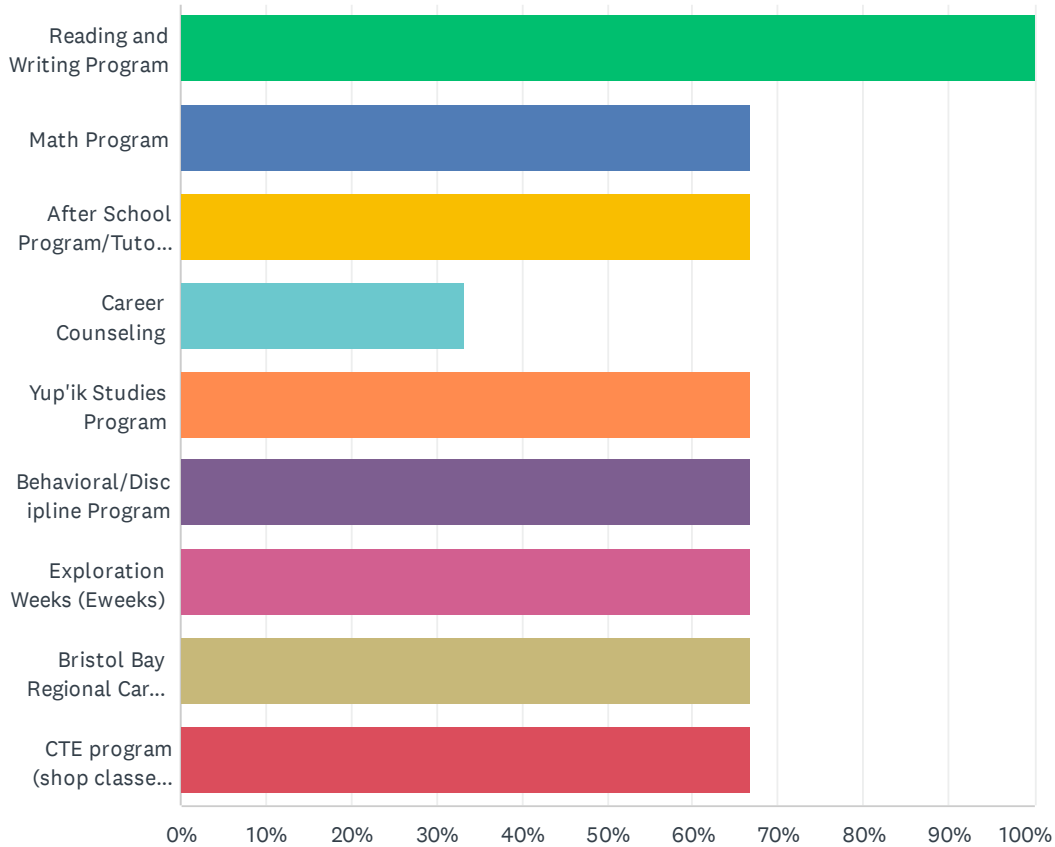

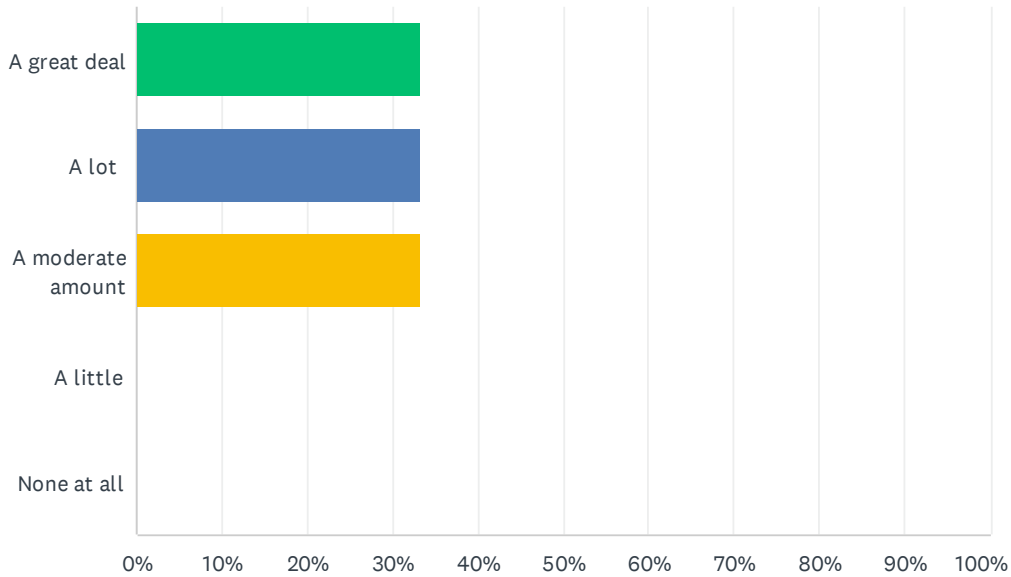

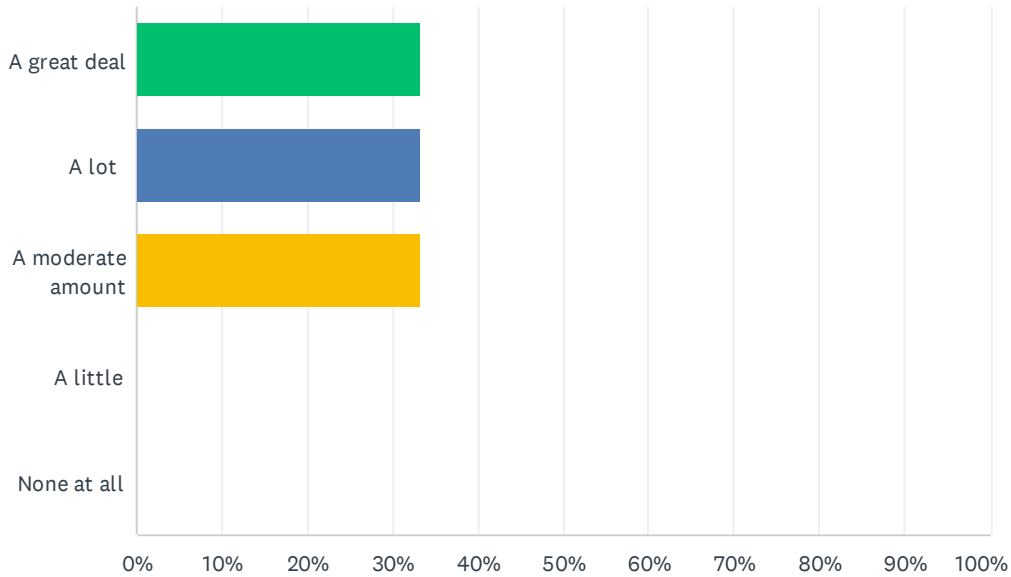

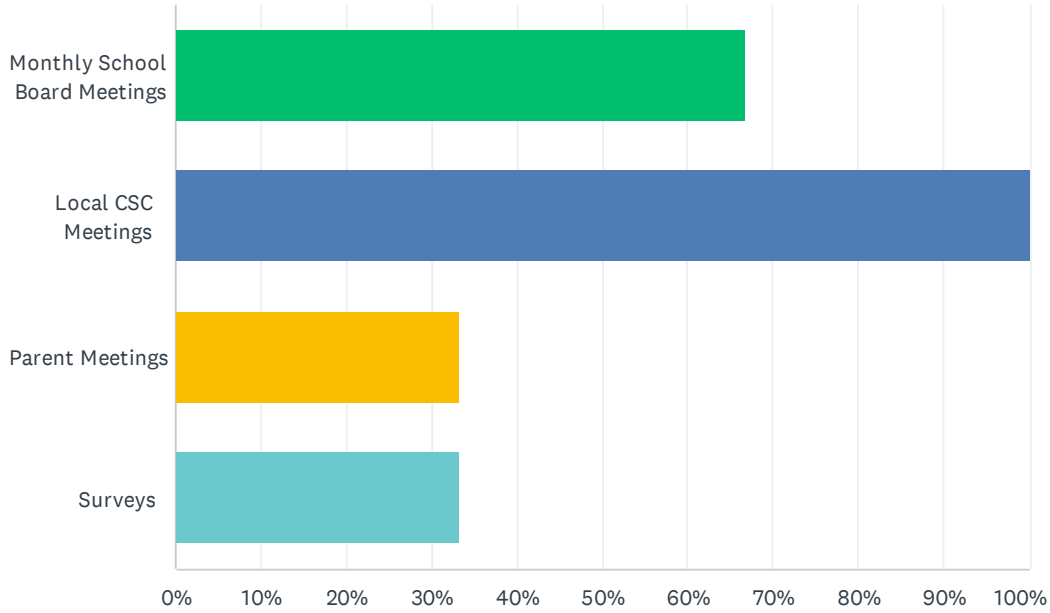

Q7 Please select the best way for a Tribal Council representative to provide feedback about educational programs?

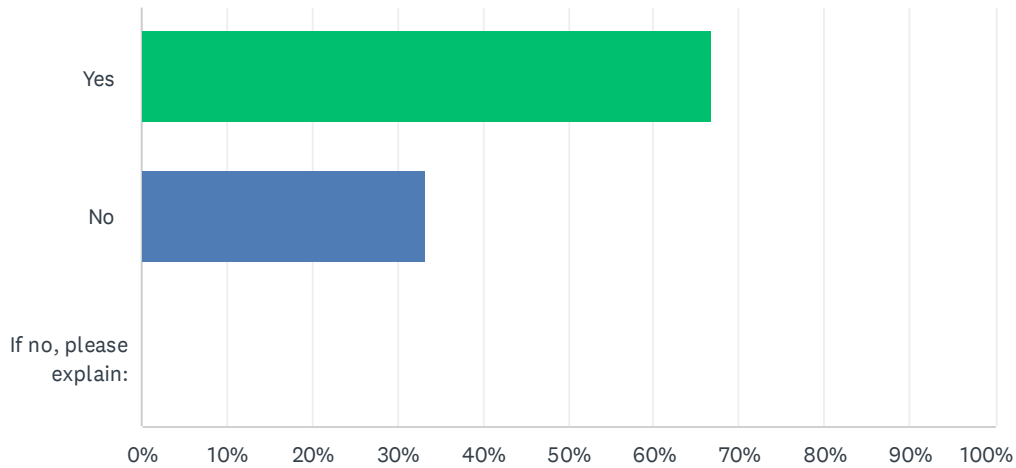

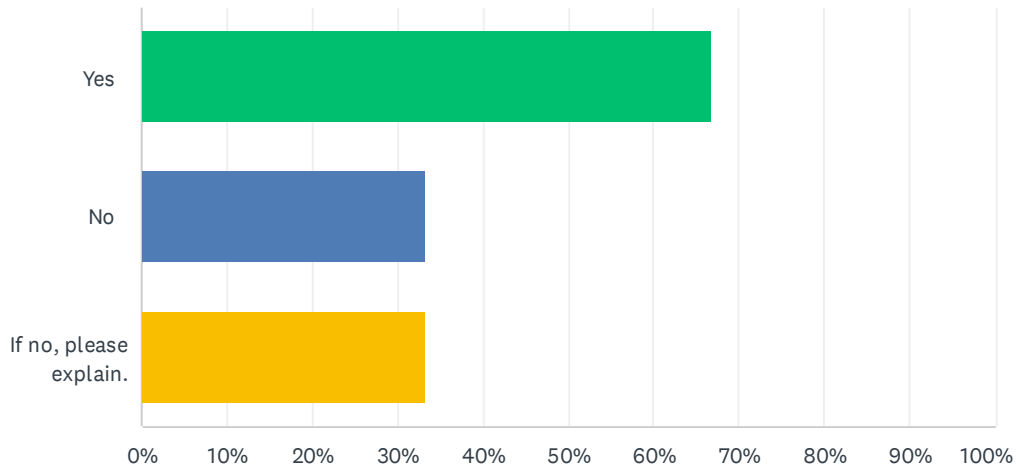

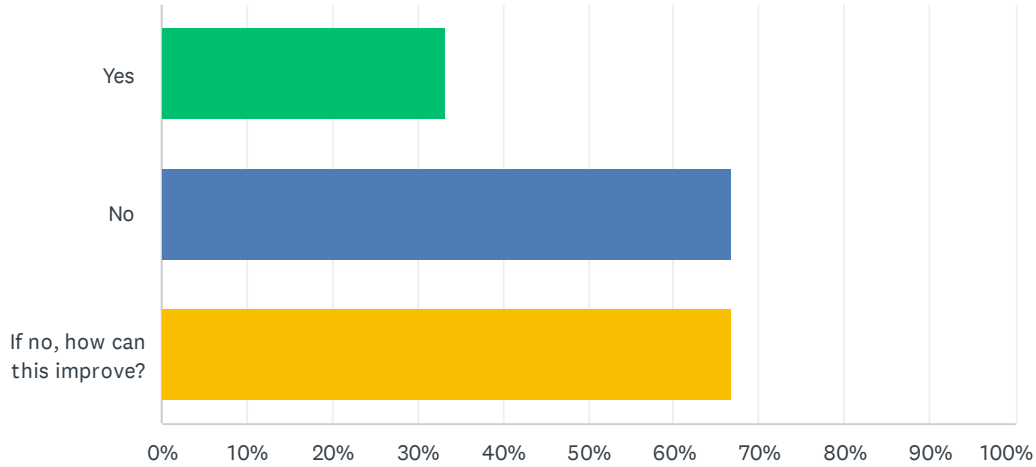

Q10 In your opinion of the Tribal Council, does the district actively seek Tribal input about the educational programs in the district?

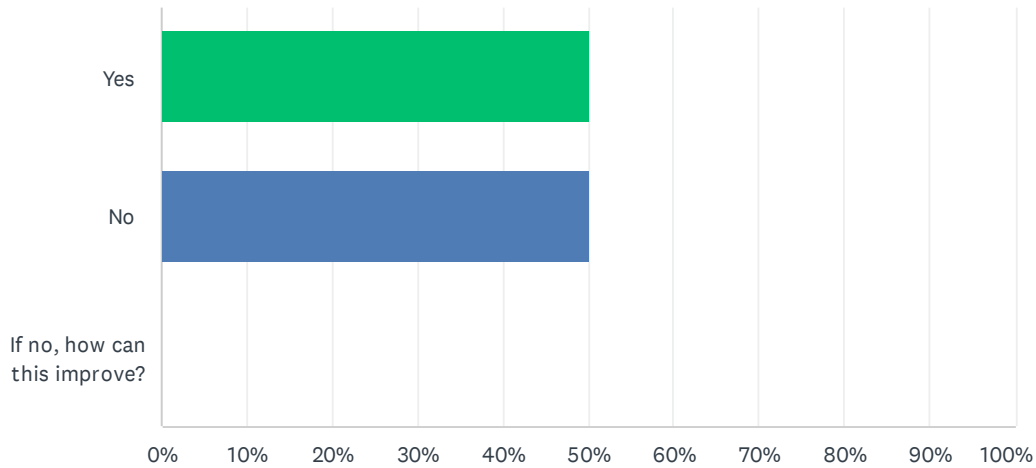

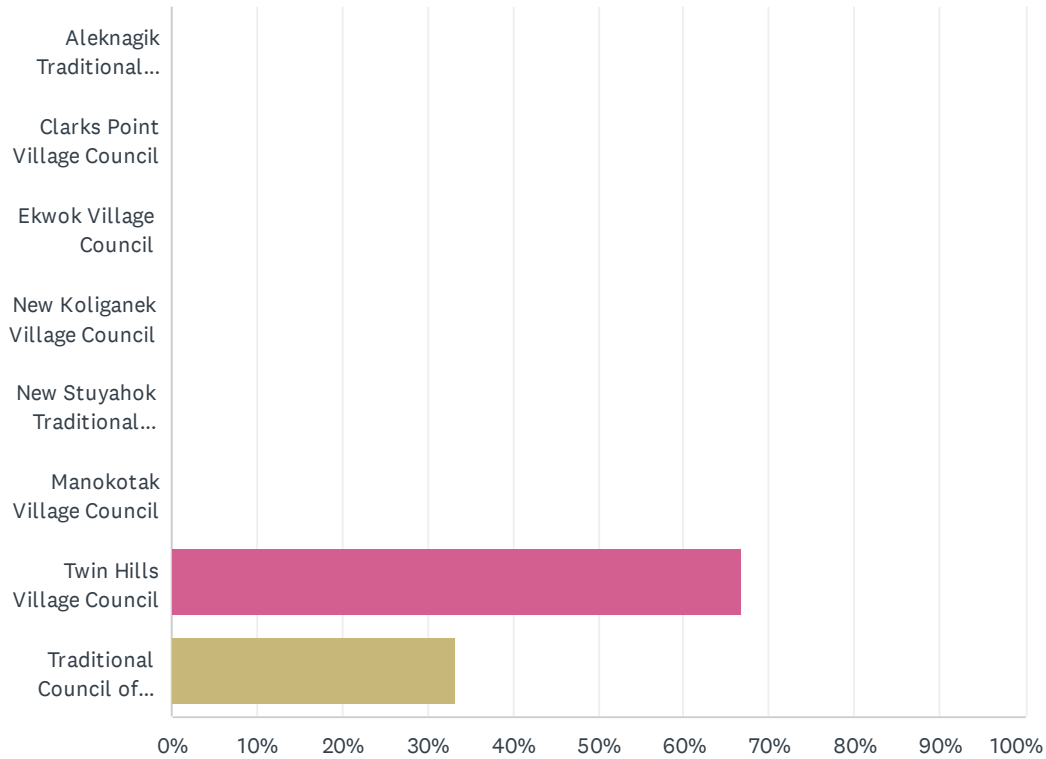
