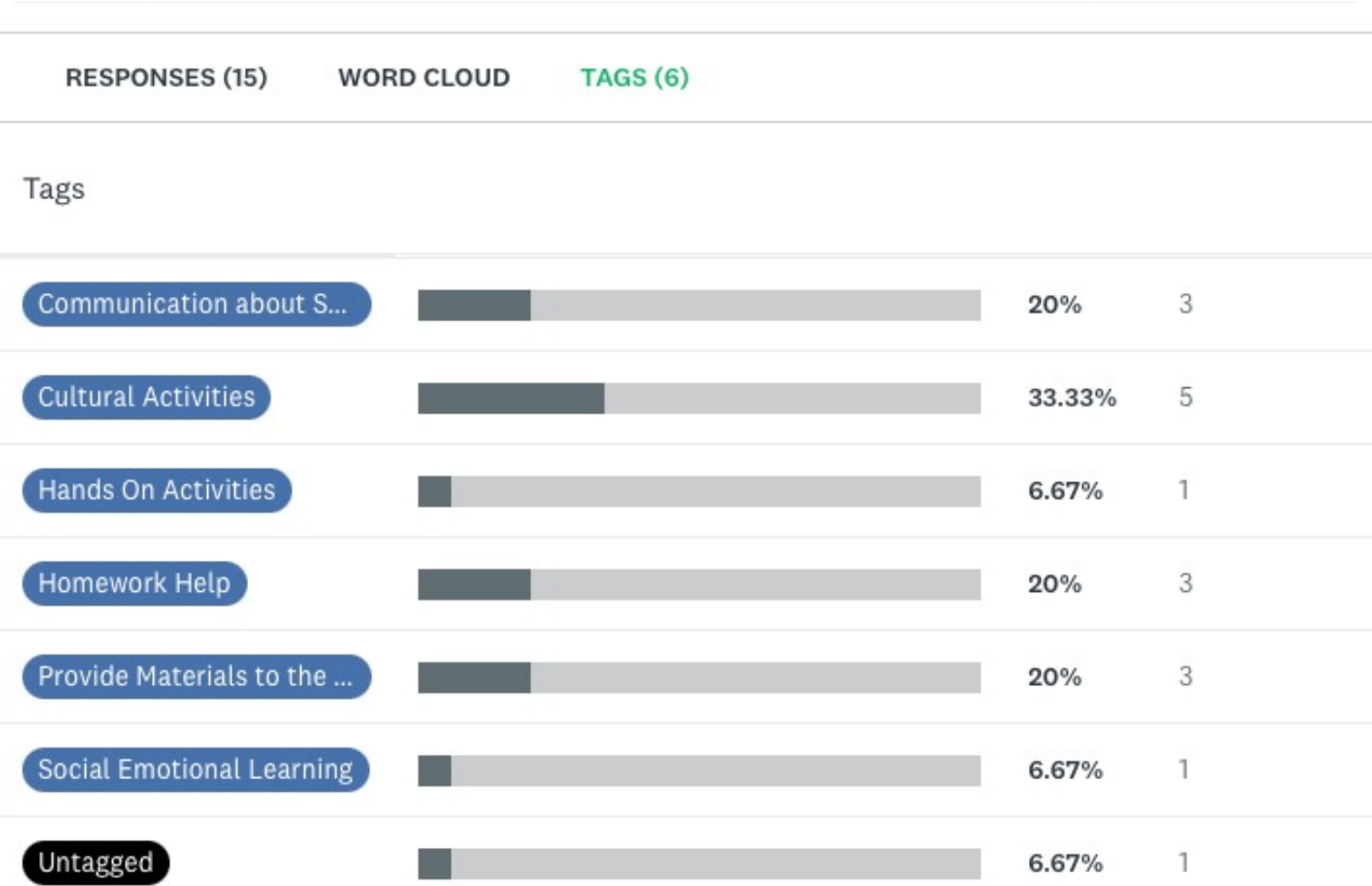

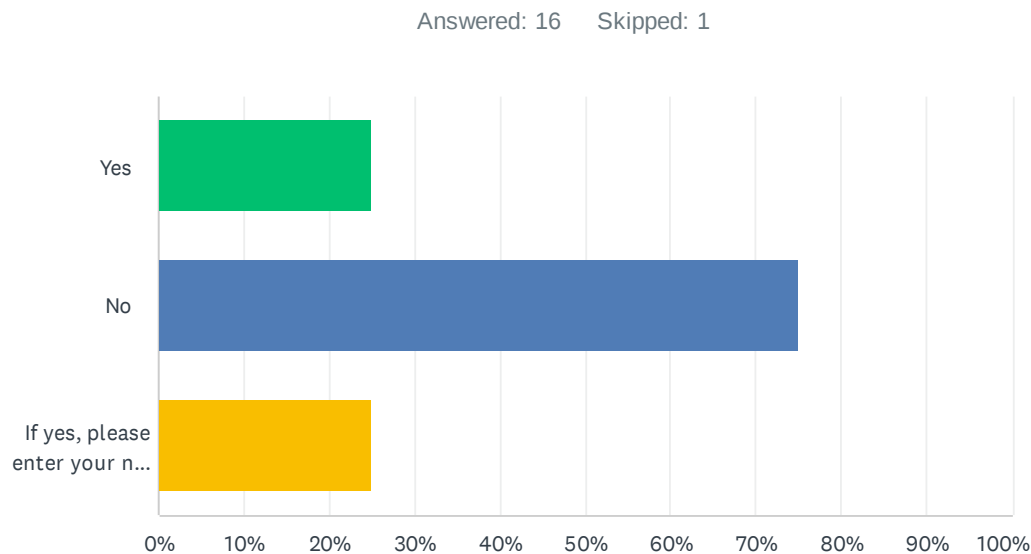


Q1 In what ways can the district to help you support your child's education at home? Examples including strategies to support reading, homework help, parenting tips, cultural activities, etc.

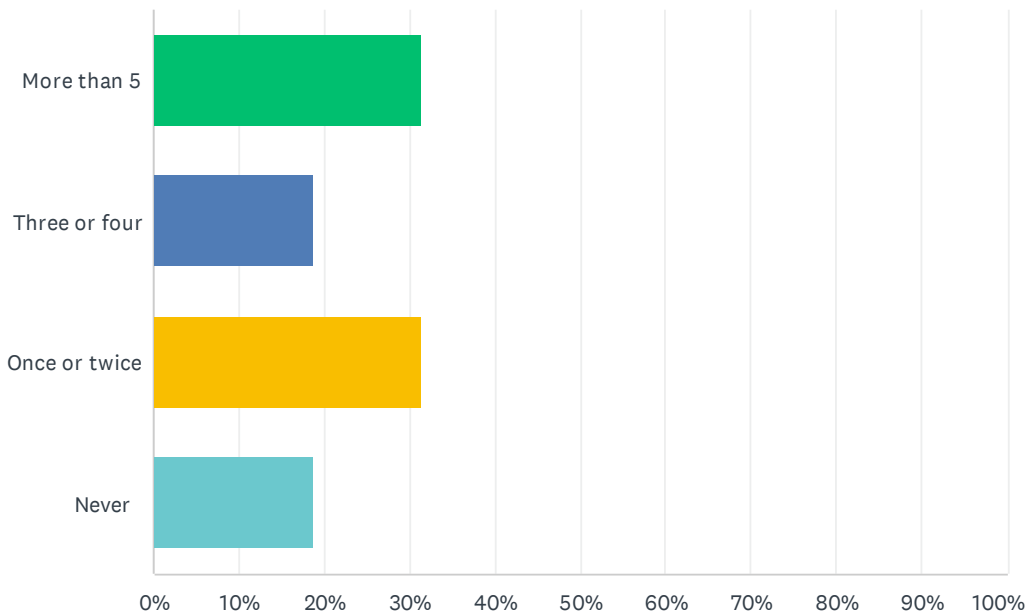

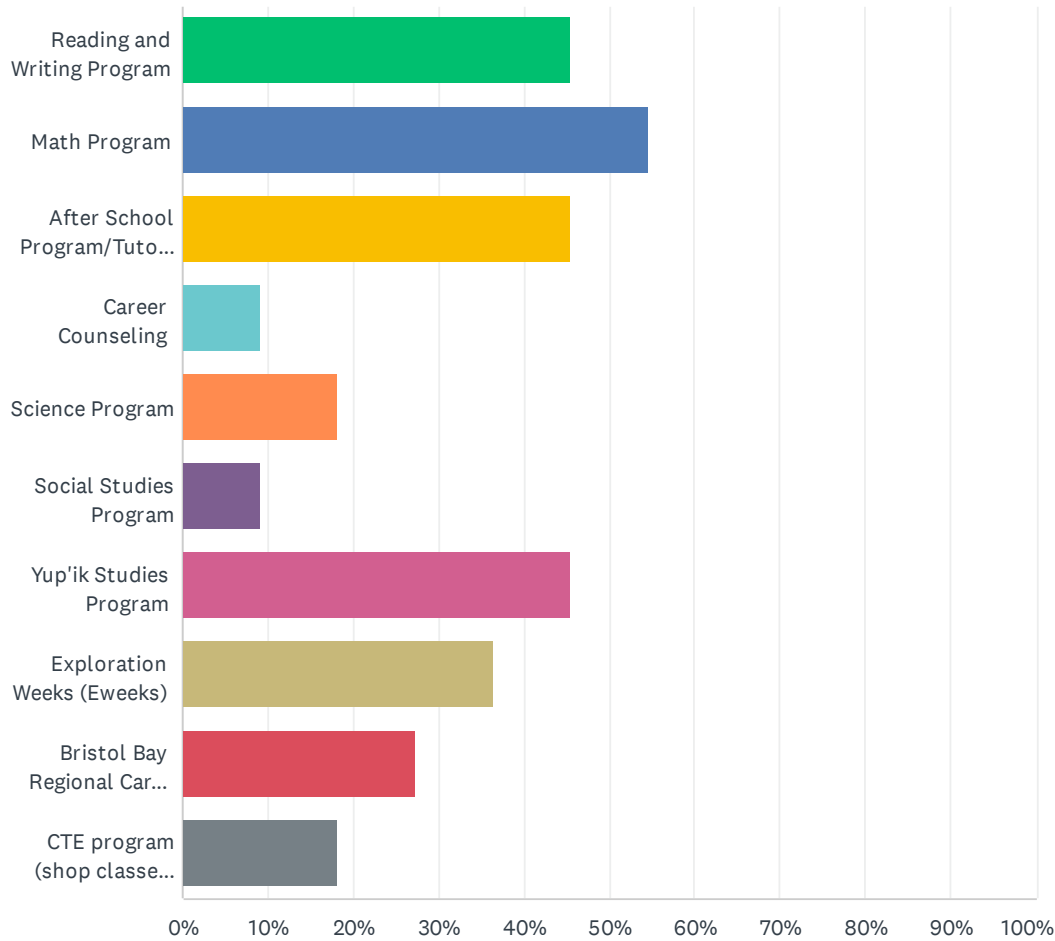

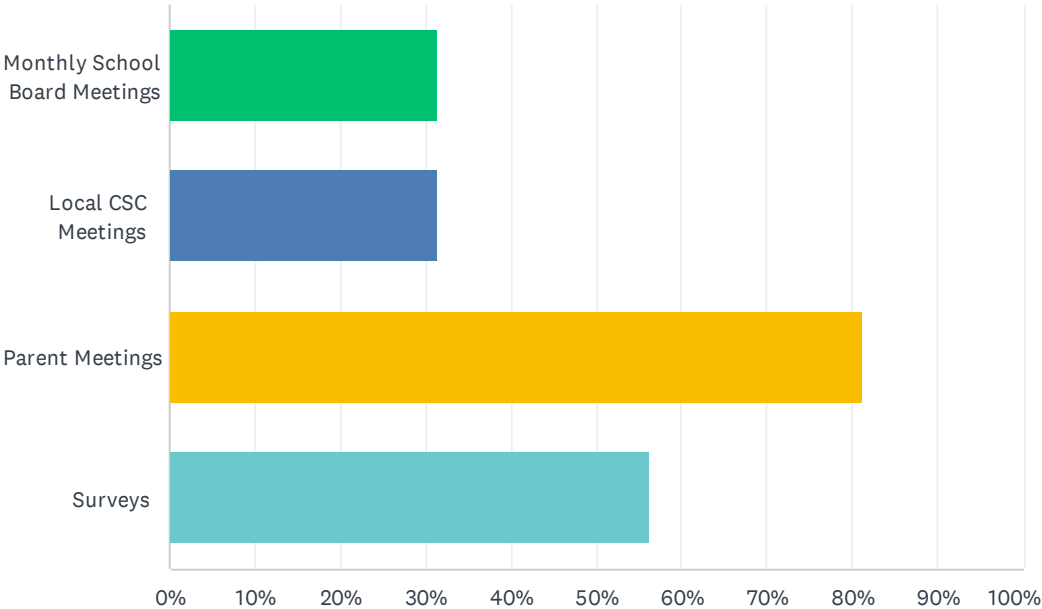

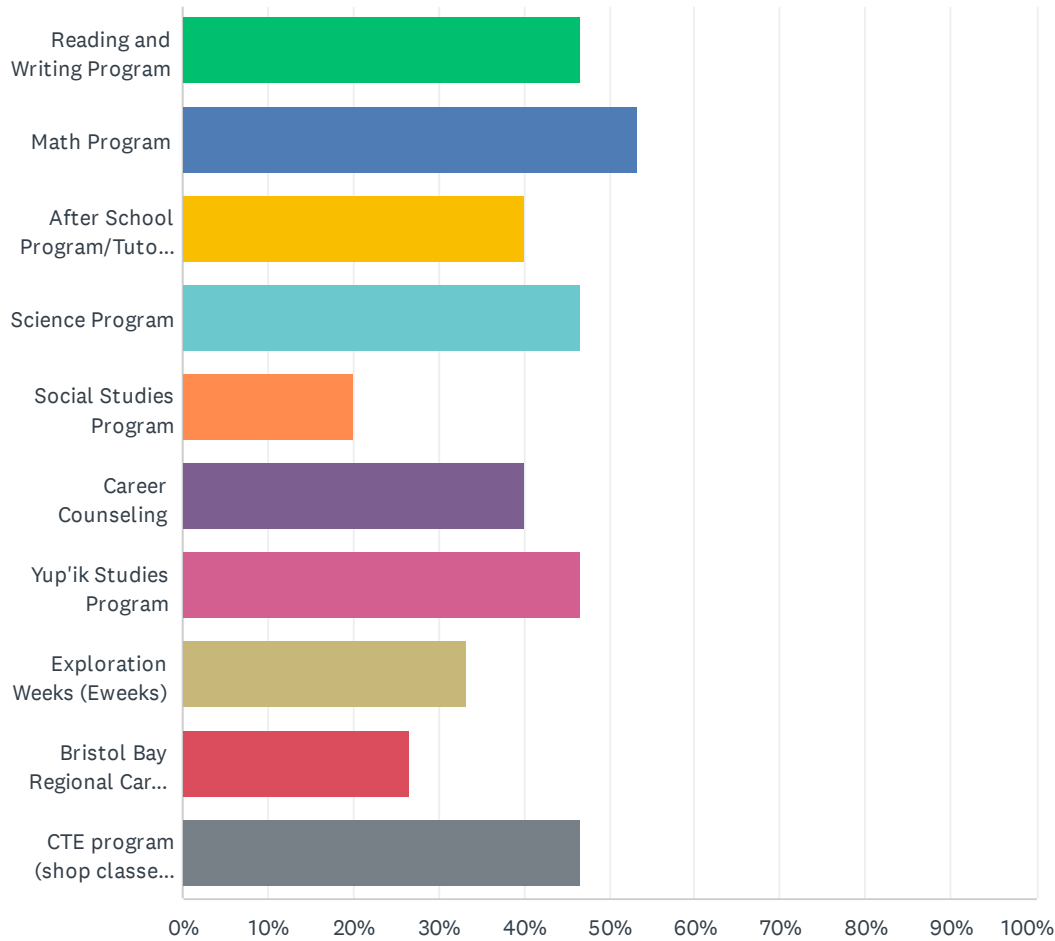

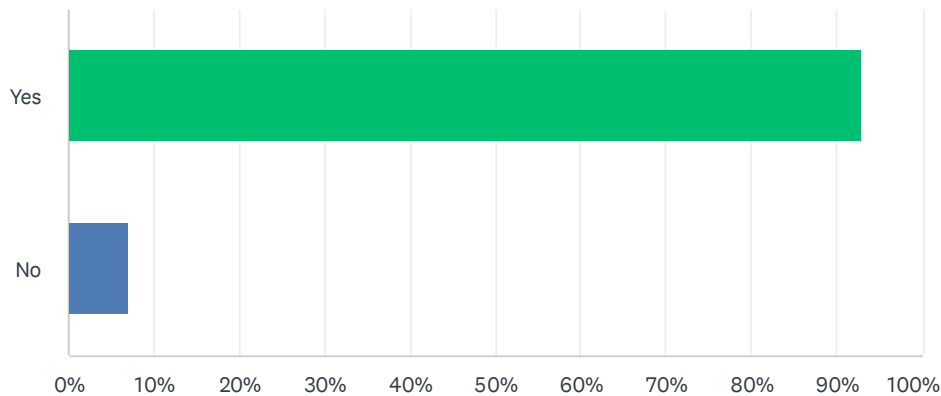

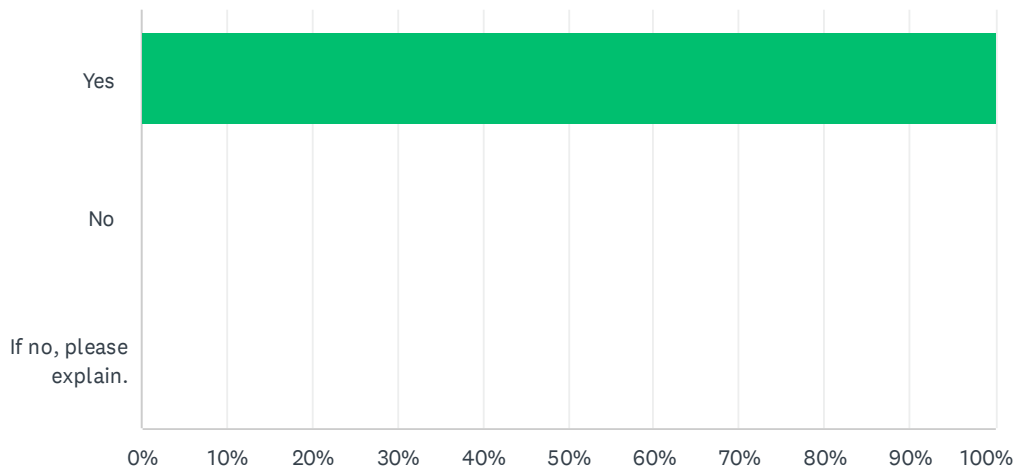

Q8 In your opinion, the Native Alaskan/Indian students in your school are given an equal opportunity to participate in sports and other after school programs when compared to non-Native students?

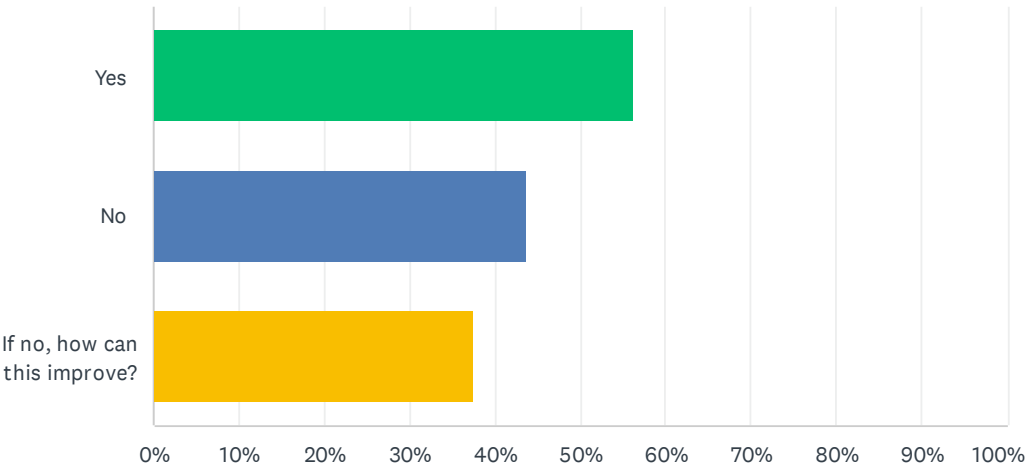

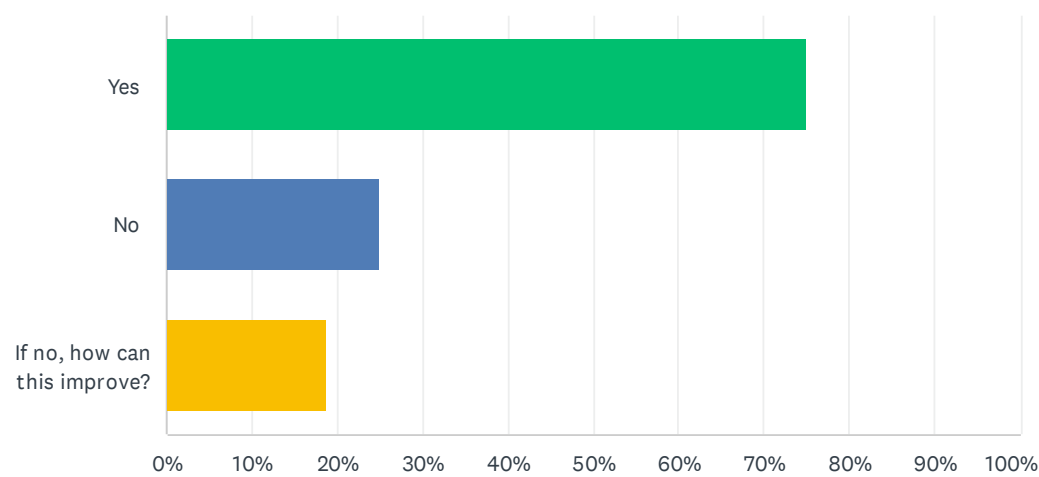

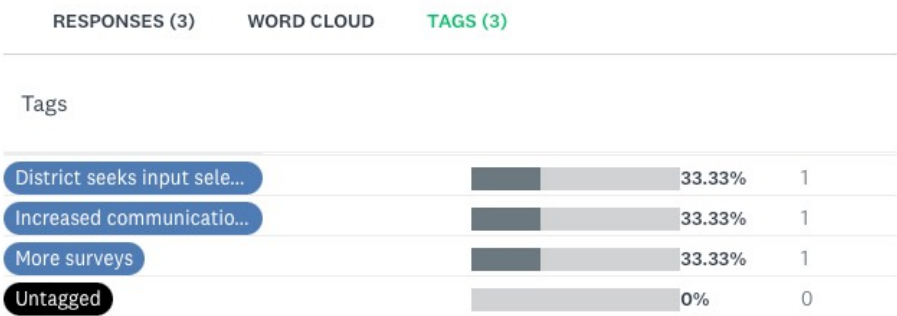

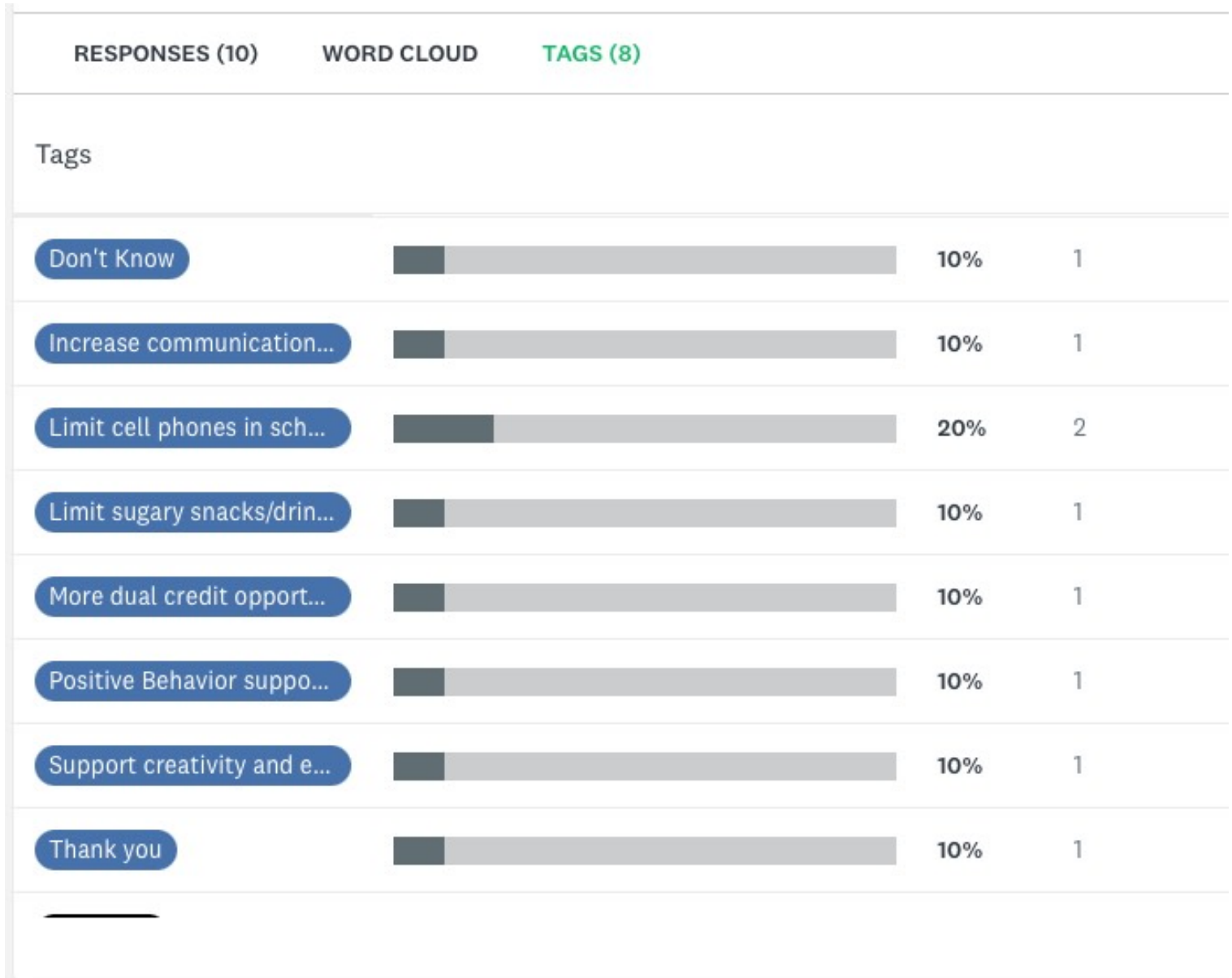

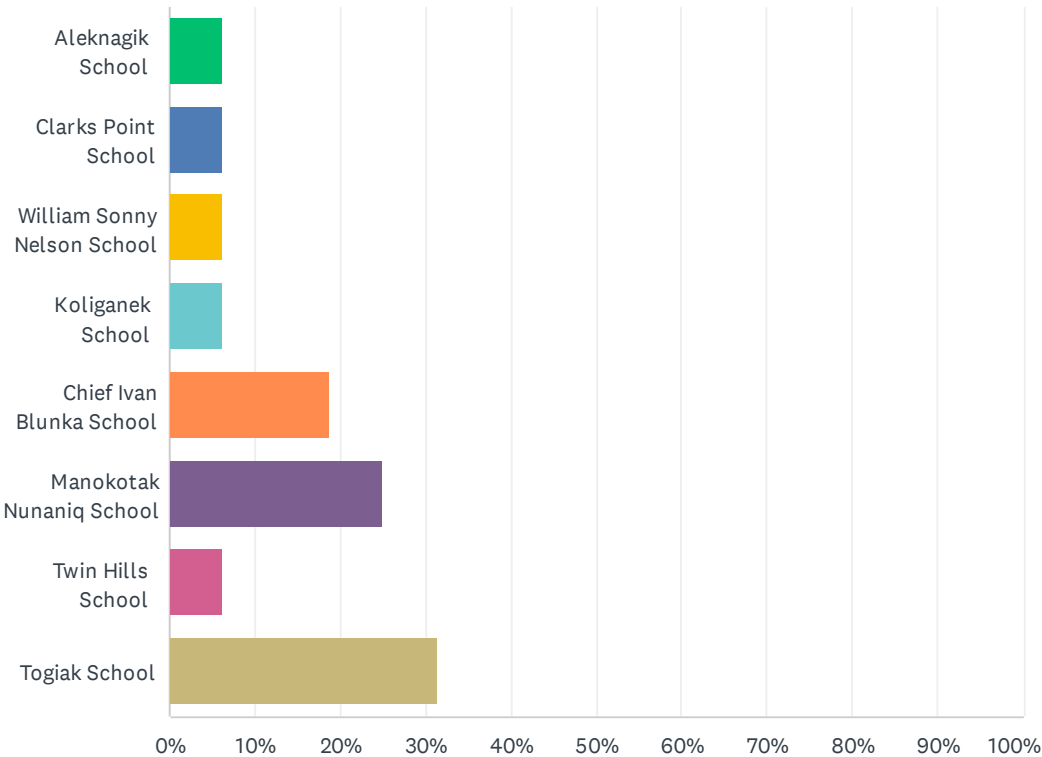

Q12 Which school does your child(ren) attend?

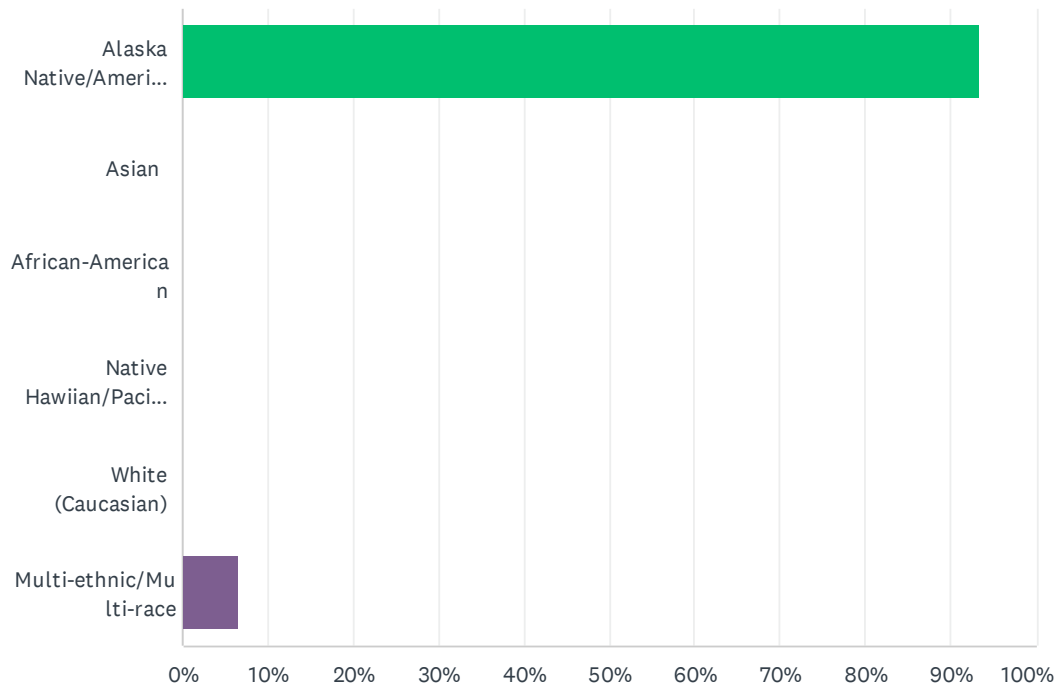

Q13 What is the ethnicity/race of your child(ren)

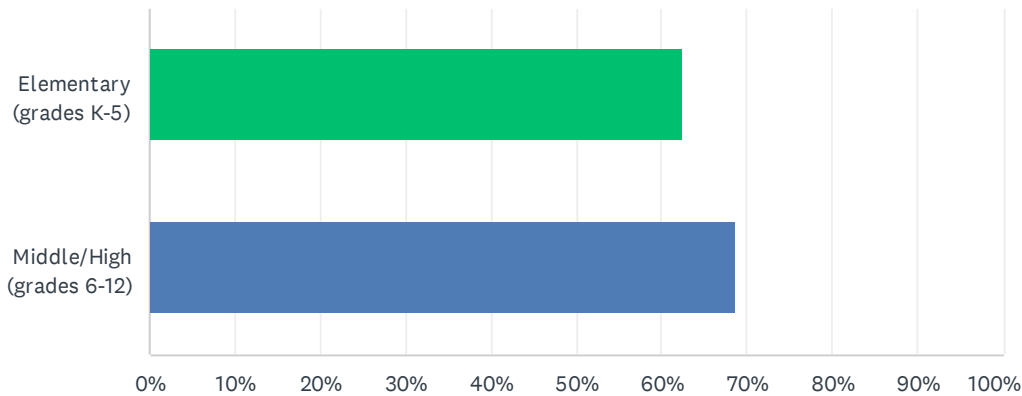
