Data

Attendance is a major focus of the school improvement plan. The team is tracking the attendance of each school so that we can celebrate the successes and provide support to students as necessary. The team will be reviewing the progress in reading for all elementary students.

Other Data

- Through December the average attendance rate of all students is about 81%
- Through March the average attendance rate of all student is about 83.5%. THAT'S AN INCREASE!!
- 100% of K-5 students are being monitored regularly for progress in reading.
